

# 2012 Spring Cash Lottery

## Lottery Rules

- Lottery tickets shall not be sold to a person under the age of 18 years. Adult ticket buyers are advised not to write the name of a person under the age of 18 years on the ticket stub.
- There are no restrictions to the Alberta SPCA's members to purchase tickets.
- Discounted prices (\$20 per ticket for 3 or more tickets) apply only when tickets are purchased at the same time. Otherwise, the cost of \$25 per ticket shall apply. Number of tickets equals 5,000 tickets at \$25 each and 15,000 tickets at \$20 each.
- All draws will be made at the Alberta SPCA head office at 10806 124 Street, Edmonton, AB T5M 0H3 by a person who has not purchased a ticket.
- Ticket orders must be received by 4:30 p.m. on Feb 28, 2012 for guaranteed eligibility for the early bird draw of Mar 9, 2012. Ticket orders must be received by 4:30 p.m. on Mar 20, 2012 for guaranteed eligibility for the final draw date of Mar 30, 2012.
- If all tickets are sold prior to Feb 28, 2012 all draws will be made on Mar 9, 2012 with AGLC approval. If all tickets are not sold by Feb 28, 2012 the final draw for all daily prizes will be held on Mar 30, 2012. The three Early Bird prizes will be drawn as follows: two of \$5,000 then one of \$10,000). The final prizes will be drawn in the following order: 25 prizes of \$1,000, 5 prizes of \$2,000, 2 prizes of \$5,000, 1 grand prize of \$25,000.
- Winning ticket stubs will be returned to the drum after each draw to be eligible for additional prizes.
- Winners will be contacted by telephone and mail. The prize winner has one year from the draw date to collect their prize.
- Tickets sold in Alberta only.
- Prizes are presented in the form of a cheque in the name of the ticket winner. Prizes will be either mailed to the winner, or they can be picked up by the winner at 10806 124 Street Edmonton AB during the hours of 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday to Friday. In the event a winning ticket stub has more than one name on it, the prize will be awarded to only one of the individuals identified on the ticket. The Alberta SPCA and the AGLC are not responsible for any disputes which may arise between the different individuals whose names appear on the ticket stub.
- If a prize is not claimed within one year the Alberta SPCA will contact the AGLC for permission to use the prize money in a different manner. Every effort will be made to locate the winner via telephone and mail.
- No ticket refunds will be given after the first draw is made. Ticket stubs must accompany all refunded tickets. Ticket refunds may take up to four weeks to process, and refunds will be issued in the form of a cheque.
- A minimum of 11,000 tickets must be sold by Feb 28, 2012. If 11,000 tickets are not sold by this date the Alberta SPCA reserves the right to contact the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission and ask for both sales and draw date extensions.
- All draws are video taped, and members of the public may view the tape or attend the draws. All costs incurred with participating in these activities are the responsibility of the individual, not the Alberta SPCA.
- No postdated cheques please.
